

**INCIDENT POLICY** 

### Rationale

- All practicable steps are taken to get immediate medical assistance for a child who is seriously injured or who is seriously ill, and to notify a parent of what has happened (HS27)
- A procedure outlining the service's response to injury, illness and incident, including the review and implementation of any practices as required (HS27)
- Where there is a serious injury, illness or incident involving a child while at the service that is required to be notified to a specific agency, the service provider must also notify the Ministry of Education at the same time. (HS34)

### Objectives

• To ensure all teachers are aware of Pebbles' response to all incidents involving children, teachers or other adults.

Definition of incidents may include but are not limit-ed to:

- Child/teacher is exposed to a threatening person or situation
- Child is left unattended
- Child leaves the centre unattended
- Suspicion of abuse of a child
- Any allegation made against a staff member
- Any incident that may occur on the centre premises involving parents, visitors or any member of the community.

### **Incident Procedures**

- If a child, kaiako or other adult is involved in an incident while at the service that requires investigation this will be recorded on the Injury, Illness or Incident Form.
- Parents, whānau or adults involved will be required to complete a written acknowledgment.
- If the incident is required to be notified to a specified agency, then the Serious Injury, Illness or Incident Form will be completed. The Ministry of Education will also be notified at this time.

# Specified Agencies will include but are not limited to:

- Worksafe NZ
- The NZ Police
- The Ministry of Health
- Oranga Tamariki
- The Teaching Council of NZ

# If a child leaves the centre licensed space unsupervised:

- If a child leaves the centre unsupervised, this will be treated as a serious incident and we will follow the Missing Child procedures from the MOE Emergency Management Plan
- The Person Responsible will identify when the child was last seen and notify the owner
- A teacher will be nominated to search the school and surroundings
- If the child is found and is injured, the Person Responsible will call for medical assistance and follow our Injury Policy
- If the child is found and not injured, they will return to Pebbles and the Person Responsible will inform the owner that the child has been found.
- The Person Responsible will inform the parents.
- If the child is not found, the Person Responsible will notify Police and the parents immediately
- The Serious Injury, Illness or Incident Form will be completed and the MOE will be informed.
